Sparkling Wine

Cooks Brut Sparkling (USA) 29

Pale straw, candied fruit, pear and grape aromas, medium sweet fruit flavours and soft easy finish, easy drinking

Ruffino Brut Prosecco (ITA) 42

Pale straw, candied fruit, pear and grape aroma, medium sweet fruit flavors and soft finish, easy drinking

Cordonoi Brut Classic Cava (SPA) 55

Spanish sparkling wine made in the traditional Champagne method. Pale gold in color with a fine mousse; citrus, biscuit and fresh pear aromas; creamy apricot flavor with a soft toasty finish; medium bodied with a refreshing touch of citrus.

Violette Sparkling Brut (CAN) 65

It's a serene blend of our estate Pinot Noir and Chardonnay, made in the Charmat Method. Violette is a light and elegant wine, perfectly balanced to refresh and intrigue. The aromatic notes consist of white fruit, pear, and peach and invigorate the senses.

Cuvée Catharine Rosé Brut, Henry of Pelham, Niagara VQA, (CAN) 74

Veuve Clicquot Ponsardin Brut Champagne (FRA) 158

Brut Carte Jaune offers a perfect balance of finesse and forcefulness. Blended with the three grapes of Champagne; Pinot Noir for structure, Pinot Meunier to round out the blend, and Chardonnay providing elegance and sophistication, essential to a perfectly balance wine.

Moët & Chandon Dom Perignon 2003 (FRA) 450

The flagship wine of Moët and Chandon, Dom Perignon is a vintage only assemblage of the finest grapes in a single year. The 2003 vintage has been compared with great vintages such as 1947, 1956, and 1976; with the growing conditions being exceptionally difficult throughout the winter and spring, the remaining fruit was subject to intense heat during the summer months. The bouquet spirals through sweet, bright floral notes and the lively minerality so typical of Dom Perignon; then notes of candied fruit, incredible freshness and finally hints of spice, brioche, and licorice root. The ultimate celebration Champagne.

White Wine

Canada

Pelee Island Winery, Chardonnay, V.Q.A 41

Pale lemon in colour. The nose shows soft jasmine notes and ripe fruit. The palate is elegant with a classic, flinty minerality, balanced by soft, creamy fruit.

Pelee Island, Vinedressers Series, V.Q.A. Ontario 45

A vivid straw color with aromas of passion fruit, medium acidity. Sauvignon blanc, Viognier, and Chardonnay combine and blend perfectly to create this wonderful Canadian wine.

Lighthouse, Riesling, V.Q.A Ontario 46

A very fruit forward, crisp and refreshing off dry Riesling, it has beautiful citrus notes of lemon and lime as well as green apple, and layers of tangerine and passion fruit. A touch of sweetness is very well balanced with good acidity, leaving a lingering and crisp finish

Vintage Ink, 2014, Chardonnay, Niagara Peninsula VQA 48

Lush tropical fruit, juicy pear and delivers a crisp refreshing finish

White Wine continued

Thomas Bachelder, “Minéralité” Chardonnay, Niagara VQA 59

Lifted, enticing orange-peel aromas, fresh mint and a faint mealy note too. Intriguingly edgy - almost a bit like a low-sulphur style, although there's nothing unfresh here. Loads of cereal and dried hay on the finish - lovely to taste such esoterica within Chardonnay.

Estate Chardonnay, Westcott Vineyards, VQA Vinemount Ridge 69

This flinty-tasting Chardonnay shows aromas of zesty lemon, fresh green apple and white flowers and on the palate the same citrus/tree fruit characteristics followed by a distinct mineral finish

France

Domaine de l'Amandine, 2016, Côtes-du-Rhône Blanc AOC 49

Zinck Portrait Pinot Blanc, A.O.C. Alsace 59

Portrait Pinot Blanc offers immense class and finesse at a truly competitive price level. It is a bright, floral, pure wine, with ripe peach flavours and a beautifully silky texture. Perfectly balanced, the finish is crisp and fresh. Supple, fruity and medium bodied.

Domaine De La Villaudière, A.O.C. Sancerre 79

This wine is expressive on the nose, combining floral fragrances with aromas of white peach and exotic fruit. Well balanced and honest on entry, the wine is underpinned by freshness and powerful, long-lasting acidity on the finish, revealing a lovely minerality. Sancerre in the upper Loire Valley is the benchmark for sauvignon blanc in Europe – crisp and fruity, with racy acidity.

Domaine Damp, Chablis, A.O.C. Chablis 82

Pale lemon in colour. The nose shows soft jasmine notes and ripe fruit. The palate is elegant with a classic, flinty minerality, balanced by soft, creamy fruit. Situated in the far north of Burgundy, Chablis' specialty is its renowned white wine, made from the Chardonnay grape. The lime-rich soil, full of small marine fossils, gives the wines of Chablis their unique mineral quality.

Italy

Ruffino, Lumina Pinot Grigio, Delle Venezie 41

The palate is soft and round with a long, clean citrus finish. Straw yellow in colour, with a fruity nose that has hints of hazelnuts. The wine is light to medium-bodied, fruity with well-balanced acidity.

Terre Gaie Pinot Grigio Poggio Bracco, Veneto 46

This is a light, dry and bright wine, refreshing, with fine delicate acacia flower, citrus and nutty aromas. The palate follows through with light citrus and hazelnut overtones. A perfect patio wine!

Jasci & Marchesani, Trebbiano D'Abruzzo DOC, Abruzzo, 52

Schreckbichl-Colterenzio, Pinot Grigio, Alto Adige DOC 58

Fragrant aromas of exotic fruit, citrus and Golden Delicious apple.

Australia and New Zealand

Nobilo, Sauvignon Blanc, Marlborough, New Zealand 45

Aromas of citrus and freshly cut grass with citrus, melon, and spice flavours. This fresh and bright sauvignon blanc is unoaked.

Appleby Lane, Sauvignon Blanc, Nelson, Australia 57

The nose is aromatic with citrus, lime, gooseberry and herbaceous characters. A mouth-filling palate showing delicious gooseberry, grapefruit and citrus fruit flavours with typical mineral edge. Rich and concentrated, the mid-palate remains clean, ripe and fresh.

White Wine continued

United States

Leaping Horse, Chardonnay, California 42

This light-bodied Chardonnay is refreshingly simple and easy to drink. Lovely tropical fruit aromas combined with apple and pear flavours, dry and crisp with the slightest hint of vanilla oak on the finish.

Kung Fu Girl, 2016, Riesling, Washington State 54

Clear, pale lemon; delicate aromas of lychee, white peach, floral blossom, lemon and mineral; off-dry, light to medium bodied; vibrant acidity and flavours of white stone fruit, apricots, apple and lime leaves.

Rose Wine

Delphine, Cabernet Franc, VQA Vinemount Ridge 43

This Riesling bursts with lemon and lime aromas on the nose. The hint of sweetness on the palate is balanced by the backbone of acidity and displays lime, floral and mineral flavors

Daniel Chôtard, 2017, Sancerre Rosé AOC, Loire, France 72

Red Wine

Canada

Pelee Island, Reserve Merlot, V.Q.A. Pelee Island 37

Medium ruby colour; dry and medium-bodied with crisp acidity and very little tannin; berry fruit flavour with some plum notes.

Pelee Island, Shiraz-Cabernet, VQA, Ontario, Canada 46

Deep purple colour; rich and full bodied; slightly oaked; spicy herbal nose with cherry and vanilla undertones.

Vintage Ink, 2015, Merlot/Cab. Sauvignon, Niagara VQA 49

Henry of Pelham, Old Vines Baco Noir, Niagara VQA, 53

Sandhill, 2016, Syrah, Okanagan Valley, British-Columbia, Canada 54

Purple garnet colour; dry and full bodied with soft tannins and juicy mouthfeel; notes of dark plum, blueberry jam, dark chocolate and roasted coffee beans.

Thomas Bachelder, 2016, "Parfum" Pinot Noir, Niagara VQA 59

Estate Pinot Noir, Westcott Vineyards, VQA Vinemount Ridge 74

Offers pure aromas and flavours of blackberry, violet, sweet spice, black liquorice and smoke. Balanced, and on the fresh side with pleasant tannins. Vanilla, toast and dark berry accents on the finish.

South America

Septima, 2016, Malbec, Mendoza, 44

Humberto Canale Estate, Malbec, Patagonia, Argentina 49

This wine embodies the purest expression of the Patagonian terroir and the Argentine Malbec. This is a characteristic Malbec varietal, a full-bodied wine, with a complex structure, with surprising notes of red berries, eucalyptus spice and black pepper.

United States

Cloud Break, Zinfandel, Sonoma Valley, California, USA 50

Dark red colour; aromatic, full bodied and juicy; jammy fruit forward palate and a smooth velvet finish.

7 Peaks, Cabernet Sauvignon, California 51

Bright ruby colour. Sweet flavours of cherry, cassis and fresh mint are balanced nicely with just a touch of oak. The blackcurrant is persistent.

L de Lyeth, Cabernet Sauvignon, Sonoma County, California 65

This is a luscious wine with enticing aromas that are immediately evident upon opening the bottle. Crimson in colour, the wine spreads across the palate with layers of wild berry, black currant and a hint of toast.

France

Château Roc de Ségur, 2016, Bordeaux AOC, Entre-Deux-Mers 53

Domaine De La Guichard, Massif D'uchaux, A.O.C. Cotes Du Rhone Villages 58

A complex and rich mix of aromas, including black cherry, crab apple, plum, cranberry and stewed strawberry fruit, with subtle licorice and mint, as well as a bit of alcoholic weight (14.5%).

Chateau Phélan Ségur, La Croix Bonis, A.O.C. Saint-Estèphe 118

Intimately related to Château Phélan Ségur, "La Croix Bonis" comes from selected plots, mainly planted with Cabernet Sauvignon, located on the best land in Saint Estèphe. The harvest is picked entirely by hand, and carried in small trays. After strict sorting, only the very best grapes are kept. Winemaking takes place at Château Phélan Ségur, using the best techniques. Nice deep ruby colour. Fruity and expressive nose. Well balanced wine with a good structure. Fine finish.

Musar Jeune Red, Cinsault/Syrah/Cab.-Sauv., Bekaa Valley, Lebanon 77

Casa do Homem, 2017, Arinto, Vinho Verde DOC 50

Argentina

Humberto Canale Estate, Malbec, Valle del Rio Negro 49

Australia and New Zealand

Kingston Estates, Shiraz, South Australia 48

Fruit is sourced from the Mount Lofty Ranges & cooler Limestone Coast, producing a complex wine with a deep crimson red-purple colour. The full-bodied palate is rich, complex and rewarding with the flavours of blackberry, spice, eucalyptus and creamy mocha. Soft tannins support a lingering finish of toasty oak.

Mitchell, Peppertree Vineyard, Shiraz, Claire Valley, Australia 88

The palate of the Peppertree Shiraz show the spicy peppery characters of high class Shiraz. The wine is full flavoured and has a soft, almost velvety palate, which makes the wine very easy to drink.

Red Wine continued

Spain

Bodegas Bilbainas, Vina Pomal, Crianza, Rioja, Spain 56

Medium intensity of black fruits on the nose. Plum, blackcurrant with a hint of liquorice. These flavours come through onto the palate, along with the subtle oak influence. This brings with it a delicious vanilla character which marries perfectly with the black fruit flavours. This is a fruit driven Rioja, perfect for consumers who enjoy a classic Rioja without an overly prominent oak influence.

Italy

Ruffino Chianti, D.O.C 46

Deep red in colour, clear and brilliant, with violet undertones. Intense cask aromas, aromas of the Tempranillo grape. A gentle palate with moderate ageing.

Jasci & Marchesani, Montepulciano D'Abruzzo DOC, Abruzzo 52

Luigi Righetti, 2015, Campolieti Valpolicella Ripasso DOC, Veneto 52

Toerre a Cona, 2016, Chianti Fiorentini DOCG, Florence, 54

Argentiera Poggio Ai Ginepri, 2013, Barbera d'Alba DOC, Bolgheri 65

Il Poggione, D.O.C. Rosso Di Montalcino 78

91 points – Il Poggione's Rosso di Montalcino bursts from the glass with intense, layered fruit. A big, voluptuous wine, the 2011 stands out for its generous, utterly inviting personality. Hints of spices and rose petals add complexity, but in the end in 2011 the Rosso is a wine mostly of juicy, textural impact.

Luigi Righetti, Capitel De Roari Amarone, D.O.C.G. Amarone Della Valpolicella 105

This is a well-balanced Amarone that still exhibits much of the dark fruit flavours, earth and meaty components expected of this DOC. Aromas of black cherry and prunes joined by beefy and earthy aromas.
